STATEMENT OF REASONS

The Horsham District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2023 (Amendment No. 5) Order 2024 is being made because of the following reasons:

Burstow Court is a block of flats owned by Horsham District Council. Its location in Bishopric, Horsham is close to the town centre and takeaway restaurants and this results in unauthorised persons regularly using the private car parking areas associated with Burstow Court. The consequences of such unauthorised use is that parking spaces are not available for residents and their visitors. Some residents are reliant upon carers visiting throughout the day, so the availability of parking is important to their healthcare needs. Incorporating Burstow Court into the Horsham District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2023 will allow Horsham District Council's civil enforcement officers to take appropriate action to ensure only authorised parking takes place.
