West Chiltington Parish Council has prepared West Chiltington Neighbourhood Development Plan (WCNDP). The Plan sets out a vision for the future of the parish and planning policies which will be used to determine planning applications locally.

In accordance with Regulation 16 of the Neighbourhood Planning Regulations 2012 (as amended), the West Chiltington Neighbourhood Development Plan and associated supporting documents will go out to consultation from **18 October 2024 to 29 November 2024** for 6 weeks inviting representations on the submission draft WCNDP, basic conditions statement, consultation statement and the SEA/AA and HRA assessment. Policy H2b

Smock Alley/Haglands Lane proposed redevelopment - Would damage the village. This does not have sufficient, suitable road access, this does not have village support and would be actively campaigned against. I find the fact the HDC initially refused to publish the Plan at Reg 16 stating that insufficient housing had been provided and then used the fact that it hadn't been published to push this development through to be a direct display of local government at it's worst.

There is no Policy in this Plan that considers the roads and transport apart from in the section 'About WC Parish'. The school transportation service uses coaches that are not suitable or applicable with the local road system taking up 1.5 lanes of the road which is seriously unsafe and causes damage to the hedges and road surface and increases congestion at the cross. There need to be more formal restrictions to the village road infrastructure as in categorising and signage as in not suitable for HGV's

There is however sufficient car parking available for parents to use (Pub carpark and Church Hall carpark) requiring only a 5 minute walk to the school and negating the need to park on the roads in the village causing congestion and safety issues. Parents stating they want to 'drop and run' is not in fact the case when they park on the road and walk to the school.

What improvements or modifications would you suggest?

Introducing no parking zones for parents, or at least no parking areas, double yellow lines by the junctions and down The Hollows lane.

Introduction of a limit to how many times a development planning application can be submitted .
