Describe the steps you intend to take to promote the four licensing objectives:

a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note

We wish to have the option to serve alcohol with our tapas-style food offering. We do not intend to operate as a pub or nightclub.

We do not intend to open late and have reflected this in our application. To this end, I am confident that we are able to ensure that our operation supports the 4 licensing objectives and, indeed, provides a safe environment for the villagers of Henfield and the surrounding areas to enjoy a peaceful meal and drink outside of the usual pub environment.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

We are intending to be a tapas-style, food-led business that sells wine and other alcoholic beverages to accompany the food. We will implement strict ID checks to prevent underage drinking and ensure responsible service. We will maintain a zero-tolerance policy for disruptive behaviour, with clear guidelines for staff to manage conflict effectively. The premises will be monitored by cloud-storage cameras. Regular staff training will ensure awareness of drug misuse and alcohol-related harm prevention. We will cooperate with local law enforcement and community groups to stay informed about potential risks and address concerns promptly.

c) Public safety

We will adhere to all health and safety regulations, ensuring a secure and well-maintained environment for all guests. Fire exits and emergency procedures will be clearly marked and regularly tested. As a Scout leader, I have trained in First Aid. The venue will not be used as a nightclub or pub so we will not be allowing or tolerating drunken or dangerous behaviour.

Minimal risk of fire due to the nature of our food offering (pre-cooked, cold tapas being the primary food).

d) The prevention of public nuisance

As a tapas-style, food-led café, we do not anticipate being the cause of any public nuisance.

We will keep background music to a low-level. We will not be operating late nights and will not serve alcohol to anyone who appears to be detrimental to our responsibility for ensuring the prevention of public nuisance.

e) The protection of children from harm

We will strictly enforce a "no ID, no sale" policy to prevent underage drinking for anyone who appears under the age of 25. No alcohol will be served to individuals who appear intoxicated, ensuring a safe environment for all. Our premises will not allow

any inappropriate content or benaviour that could be harmful to children. Additionally, we will cooperate with local authorities and community groups to help ensure a family-friendly environment.

Also, no unaccompanied children will be allowed in the premises.
