Economic Development Team Workstream 24/25

October 2024 Update

The team of five run a programme of time specific projects and campaigns alongside ongoing work including:

- Keeping the Council's business web pages up to date.
- Planning and generating PR and social media content for the Council's Communications Team to amplify the Council's Economic Development messages and initiatives.
- Scheduling and producing content for the fortnightly <u>Business Newsletter</u> (2,300+ subscribers).
- Content and contract management of the West Sussex Business Hub (WSBH).
- Distributing 'Welcome Pack' letters to all new business start-ups in the District.
- Monitoring and reporting vacancy rates on the high streets of our seven towns/villages.
- Providing economic development input to commercial planning applications and enquiries.
- Scheduling and commissioning content for Horsham Town Centre entry signage and banner sites.
- Monitoring and reporting on Horsham District's economic performance indicators.

In addition, the team are managing the Council's two-month consultation process on its Draft **Economic Development Framework and Business Charter** and will be formulating a final Cabinet approved suite of plan documents by February 2025.

- <u>Business Training Programme</u> Spring 2025 (part-funded by UK Shared Prosperity Fund [SPF])
 - Targeted at SME owners.
 - o Procuring and organising Horsham District Council's training programme.
 - o Marketing and promotion of workshop bookings and online video resources.
 - KPI and feedback monitoring.
 - Defining future programmes in context of local demand and existing provision by others.

LEAP 2024 – Small business grant programme including green business grants (Success Stories)

- Applications require submission of a business plan and are approved by a Panel.
- Fund currently closed whilst processing 32 applications with a value of £64,000 to be claimed.
- Looking for approval to fund a further round of grants in the final quarter 2024.

SPF & <u>REPF</u> Government Grants programmes – nearly £2 million before 1/4/2025

- Developing and commissioning SPF projects that meet Government criteria to fully use funds.
- Managing or supporting 3rd party run projects to maximise value and collaboration.
- Supporting, recording, and reporting to Government on project outcomes (Until May 2025).

• Buy Local Gift Happy - Christmas 2024

- o Annual public campaign to promote sustainable local shopping.
- Grants to support Community Christmas Events across the District in return for campaign publicity.
- <u>Christmas Display Magic competitions</u> across District High Streets and Markets, this year with 7 media partners to boost publicity.

• Sussex Six B2B – funded until April 2025 (SPF)

- <u>Local food and drink campaign</u> run by Natural Partnerships, led by Horsham District Council
- o 91 businesses have now pledged to use or stock 6 new Sussex products.
- 120 plus unique businesses have engaged in quarterly workshops.
- Adopted by Gatwick Airport, Chichester and (soon) Mid Sussex District Councils.

Horsham District Volunteer Support Fund & Training (SPF)

 Collaborating with Horsham District Council's Voluntary Sector Support team to manage a Volunteer Support Fund offering grants of between £500 and

- £4,000 towards projects that assist organisations upskill existing volunteers and recruit new ones.
- Monitor and report results and feedback to inform future work.

• HD Visitor Experience Development Audit & Grants - (SPF) by end March 2025

- Manage contract with Experience Sussex to:
 - <u>Audit</u> existing Visitor Economy experiences and sector skills needs in Horsham District.
 - Manage a scheme to foster the development on new experiences including a grant fund.
- o Audit completed Autumn 2024 listing 121 businesses operating in the sector.
- o 33 expressions of interest (to date) in developing a new Visitor Experience.
- Economic Development are using feedback to help shape One Council Economic Development Framework support needs.

Drink Producers of Horsham District – 2nd Edition Spring 2025

- <u>First edition in 2024</u> mapped all producers of alcoholic beverage producers in digital and printed formats and was widely acclaimed.
- A second edition will be updated and include non-alcoholic beverage producers based on feedback.
- Adds to our knowledge on how to support this growing sector.

Employment Hubs by Adam Knight & Associates (SPF) - funded till Spring 2025 (under development)

- Providing Employment Support across Horsham District to meet KPIs.
- Manage contract and support publicity of resources.
- Monitor and report results to inform Economic Development Framework employments and skills agenda.

• Horsham Apprenticeship Fair – February 2025

- Follow up to <u>September's successful Jobs and Skills Fair</u> in Apprenticeship Week.
- o Organise, solicit business participants, publicise to public and run.
- o Opportunity to strengthen stakeholder partnerships.

Young Entrepreneurs Programme – funded to April 2025 (SPF) under development

- Business support for aspiring entrepreneurs to help them test and plan their business ideas.
- Manage and locally publicise the programme run by Digital Islands for Horsham District Council.

Environmental Health Training, Compliance and Support– funded to April 2025 (SPF) (under development)

- Market Traders gas safety audit and support towards compliance.
- Commission the <u>SALSA</u> certification project to support up to 10 small businesses to meet contract requirements for larger scale customers.

• Co-Working Space – (SPF) (under development)

 Use of £150k by Horsham District Council to create new co-working space within new Horsham District Council Offices potentially to be operated by Freedom Works.

Bishopric & Carfax scheme development Market Operations input (under development)

 Provide input to infrastructure scheme development to drive functionality for market Operations and foster maximum economic benefit for businesses overall.
