- 4. The required deposit of £500 may be made either by the deposit of any legal tender, by means of a banker's draft or the electronic transfer of funds.
- 5. If the election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday, 4th July 2024.
- 6. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on Tuesday, 18 June 2024. Applications can be made online: https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote.

New applications to vote by post, and amendments or cancellations of existing postal votes or proxy vote arrangements must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Horsham District Council, Parkside, Chart Way, Horsham, RH12 1RL by 5 p.m. Wednesday, 19 June 2024. - 8. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Wednesday, 26 June 2024. Applications can be made online: https://www.voter-authority-certificate.service.gov.uk.
- 9. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Horsham District Council, Parkside, Chart Way, Horsham, RH12 1RL by 5 p.m. on Wednesday, 26 June 2024. Some applications can be made online: https://www.gov.uk/apply-proxy-vote
- 10. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Horsham District Council, Parkside, Chart Way, Horsham, RH12 1RL by 5 p.m. on Thursday, 4 July 2024. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Wednesday, 26th June 2024. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 p.m. on Wednesday, 26th June 2024.
